New Home Cleaning Checklist

Bathrooms

- Wipe down windows, mirrors, cabinets, and bathroom hardware
- Scrub the tub and shower - use a scrub brush for tough dirt and make sure your cleaning solution is specific to your shower material.
- Disinfect the toilet - Don't forget to get the base of the toilet
- Clean the counter & sink - use an old toothbrush to scrub around seams and tight spaces

Kitchen

- Wipe Cabinets and drawers
- Clean the major appliances
- Dishwasher
 - Soak the racks and filter in warm water and distilled vinegar
 - Wipe out all food particles
 - Fill a bowl with 1 cup of white vinegar and run the dishwasher on a hot water cycle.
 - After the first cycle ends, remove the bowl and sprinkle 1 cup of baking soda across the bottom and run on a short cycle
- Stove
 - Soak all racks and drip pans in hot, soapy water
 - With an oven cleaner solution, clean the inside of the oven.
 - Use a grease remover to clean the range hood.
 - Wipe the top of the stove, drawers, and dials with the proper cleaning utensils
 - Clean the floor under the stove
 - Scrub the elements soaking and reassemble

- Refrigerator
 - Remove drawers and bins and wash them with hot soap and water
 - Wipe out the inside of the fridge
 - Pull out the fridge and dust and wipe the sides and the back. Clean the floor and reassemble
- Clean the sink - pour baking soda and water down the drain to remove odors
- Wipe counters and the backsplash

Other Common Areas

- Dust light fixtures, fans, and vents
- Dust and wipe closet shelves, window sills, baseboards, doorknobs, and light switches
- Clean the floors
 - Carpet - Vacuum, steam clean the carpet, and then vacuum again
 - Wood - Sweep well first and use a wood floor cleaner to mop (make sure the mop isn't too wet so you don't damage the flooring)
 - Other - Sweep well first and then mop with the appropriate cleaning solution for the floor type.
